

General information about Czech Republic

- Czech Republic is a **safe country** with a low crime rate
- Most Czechs speak only Czech, some of them German. Younger Czechs speak also English.
- **Grocery stores** are typically open between 7 am and 8 pm. If you need groceries later in the evening, look for "BILLA STOP&SHOP" (open 24/7)
- There is a „Mc'Donald“ in Znojmo (open from 7 am until 11 pm)
- There is **no particular risk of infectious diseases**
- **Tap water is safe to drink**
- **There is a tipping practice in restaurants**, you can simply pay the list prices or if you are satisfied, you can leave a bonus of 5 to 10 percent of the price
- **Adhere to speed limits**. The fining system means that getting caught speeding is very expensive
- Corruption is virtually non-existent: you can, and should, trust authorities. **Do not attempt bribery, it will only get you into trouble.**
- **Health care:**
 - EU/ETA countries & Switzerland: present your European Health Insurance Card (EHIC)
 - Other countries: traveler's insurance
- **Weather:**
 - Expected weather during the event: morning 15 C/59 F - day 22 C/72 F - night 10 C/50 F
 - Sunrise at 7 am, sunset 9.30 pm
