## VIENNA AIRPORT – recommendation for those who travel from countries outside the EU and do not have a European firearms passport ("Non-EU citizens")

## Only one recommended process if you want to arrive to Vienna airport:

- 1. Contact and visit the Austrian Embassy in your country and obtain the APPLICATION FOR IMPORT FIREARMS CATEGORY B UNDER §39 ABS2. This application shall be accompanied by an officially verified letter of invitation and other documents which the Embassy requires.
- 2. Contact and visit the Czech Embassy in your country and obtain a Permit for Temporary Non-Commercial Importation of Firearms or Ammunition "FIREARMS WAY BILL". This application also shall be accompanied by an officially verified letter of invitation and other documents which the Embassy requires (Firearms Permit, Firearms Certificate etc.).

After arriving at the Vienna airport, you will be checked and you can travel to shooting range in Znojmo. At the Czech border is no formal police control. But during the visit you shall always carry this Firearms Way Bill document with officially verified letter of invitation and be ready to show these documents for inspection by the police officer (you must have it to moving with firearms and ammunition in the Czech Republic).

IMPORTANT: There is no way to helping you if you arrive to Vienna airport without the Application documents and Austrian police will not issue a Firearms Way Bill (Permit). That is the reason why you have to confirm all your documents previously on the Embassies in your countries.

We remind you that the best option is to fly to Prague, which is further away from the shooting range, but thanks to the fact that it is located on the territory of the Czech Republic, we are able to help.
